# **European quality schemes**



### PDO | Protected Designation of Origin

A PDO identifies an agricultural product whose quality or characteristics are essentially due to a particular geographical environment, and the production steps of which all take place in the defined geographical area.



#### **PGI** | **Protected Geographical Indication**

A PGI identifies an agricultural product whose given quality, reputation or other characteristic is attributable to its geographical origin, and at least one of the production steps of which take place in the defined geographical area.



### TSG | Traditional Specialty Guaranteed

A TSG identifies a product whose specific qualities are linked to a composition, a mode of production or a processing method corresponding to a traditional practice.



### **Organic Farming**

Organic farming is a system of food production that combines best environmental practices, a high level of biodiversity, the preservation of natural resources, the application of high animal welfare standards and the use of natural substances and processes.



The OQT "mountain product" identifies a product whose raw materials come essentially from mountain areas and, in the case of processed products, the processing
