How to reach Bordeaux center from the airport?

BY SHUTTLE

If you are travelling to Bordeaux by plane, the shuttle bus system of <u>30'direct Shuttle</u> offers you <u>scheduled routes</u> between Bordeaux Merignac airport and Bordeaux Saint Jean train station.

BY BUS

There is a bus-line going from Bordeaux airport to Bordeaux center every 10 minutes between 7 am and 8 pm during the week. The name of the line is **Liane 1+**, the ride takes approximately 45 minutes, and a bus ticket costs $1,70 \in$. The bus driver will be able to sell you one if you have coins but you can buy your public transport tickets from a terminal in the forecourt of Hall B near the bus stop for Liane 1+ at the Bordeaux airport. If you think you are going to take a lot of public transports, you can buy a 7 days pass for $14,20 \in$. This pass will allow you to use the bus and the tramway in an unlimited way for 7 days. To choose the pass that suits you the best, check here the different fares.

This bus will bring you in the Center of Bordeaux to "Gambetta", "Palais de Justice", etc. You must choose your stop according to your hotel location. Once you are in the center, you will have the possibility to take the tramway or to walk to reach your hotel.

You will need the same ticket for the bus and the tramway. The same bus/tram ticket can be used in correspondence if it was bought less than one hour ago.

The local transport provider – <u>Transports Bordeaux Métropole (TBM</u>), the bus and tram network for the city of Bordeaux, will navigate you through the different transport options in Bordeaux. Further brochures, city maps and guides can be found on the <u>Tourist Office's website</u>.

BY TAXI

The list of taxi companies at the Bordeaux airport is available <u>here.</u> The estimated cost of a taxi drive between the Bordeaux airport and Bordeaux center is $35,00 \in$. You can also choose to take the <u>Uber</u> Company that is less expensive than a normal taxi.



Speed is limited to 50 Km/h in town, and 80 or 90 Km/h out of town and 130 Km/h on motorways. Seatbelts are obliged by law for all passengers. In towns, parking is controlled and must be paid for.




Once in Bordeaux: tramway lines + BUS
